### WKCE Exams:

The No Child Left Behind Act requires that students in grades 3 and 5-7 be tested in Reading and Math only. Students in grades 4, 8, and 10 were tested in Reading, Language Arts, Math, Science, and Social Studies.

The following document indicates cumulatively, the percentage of students that scored in the “proficient” and “advanced” categories.

Scores on the WKCE are reported in four proficiency levels:

***Minimal** – Student shows limited achievement—major gaps in knowledge and tested skills.*

***Basic** – Student shows some competency in the skills tested.*

***Proficient** – Student shows competency and mastery in skills tested. Evidence present of skills necessary for progress in areas tested.*

***Advanced** – Student shows ability beyond mastery of skills tested. Test scores show in-depth understanding of academic content.*
